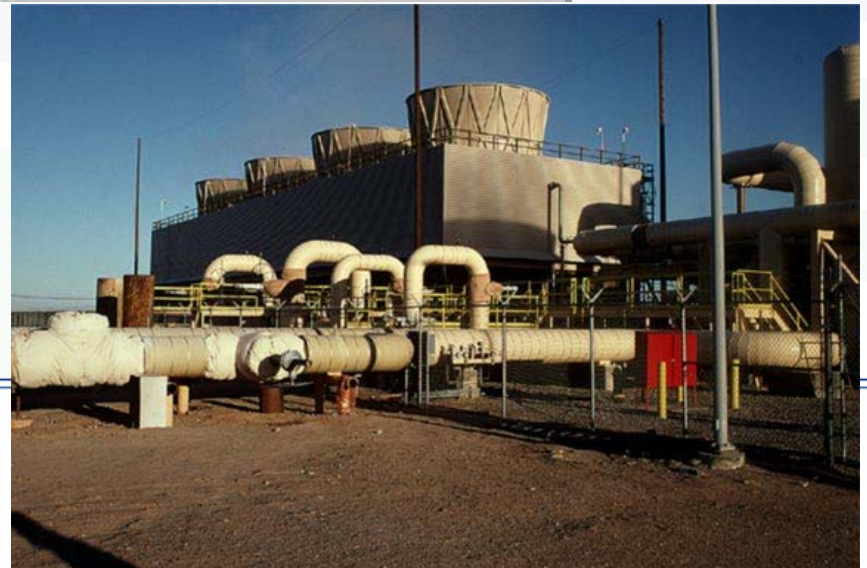
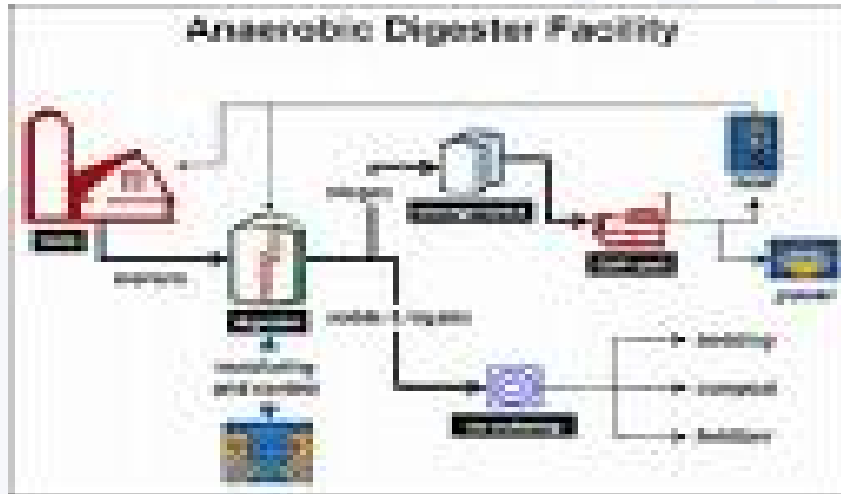

History of Section 9006

- The Farm Bill established the Renewable Energy Systems and Energy Efficiency Improvements program under title IX, Section 9006
- Congress provided nearly \$23 million to fund the program in each of fiscal years 2003-2006
- Funded projects for Oklahoma – 21 awards for \$409,304

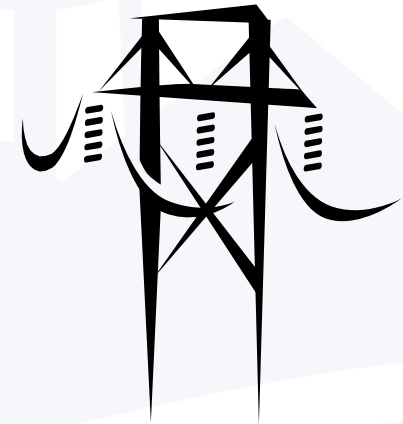


Eligible Projects

Eligibility

- Rural
 - Population less than 50,000
- Agricultural producer
- Small business - Examples
 - Construction Machinery Manufacturer – Max. 750 employees
 - Poultry Processing – Max. 500 employees
 - Office Supply store – Max. \$6.5 million
 - Grocery Store – Max. \$25 million
- Demonstrate Financial need



Program Facts

- Grant request must not exceed 25 percent of the eligible project costs.
 - Renewable energy grants can range from \$2,500 to \$500,000.
 - Energy efficiency grants can range from \$1,500 to \$250,000.
- Projects under \$200,000 total project costs qualify for a simplified application process.
- Loan guarantees can be for up to 50% of total eligible project costs. Guarantees can range from \$5,000 to \$10,000,000 per project.
- Projects can qualify for combined grant and loan guarantee, but the grant portion is still subject to the above limits and combined funding assistance cannot exceed 50% of total eligible project costs.



First Step

- Assemble a project team
 - Organize
 - Project
 - Funding
 - Technical Assistance

Second Step

- EEI projects
 - >\$50,000 – Energy assessment
 - <\$50,000 – Energy Audit
- Renewable Energy Systems
 - Feasibility study

Third Step

- Technical Report
 - Guideline
 - Team effort
 - System Installer or contractor
 - Engineer

Fourth Step

- Secure matching funds
 - Local lender
 - Rural Economic Development Loan Program
 - Small Business Administration

Fifth Step

- Complete application
 - Utilize template
 - Simplified application - <\$200,000
 - Full application - > \$200,000
